Counseling

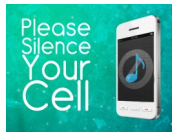

“The Clothes Of Christ”

**Luke 2:7/ Matt. 13:55/ John 19:2, 23-24/Matt. 27:31/John
20:5-7**

Swaddling Clothes

- 6 in. wide x 9 ft. long
- Jesus was laid in swaddling clothes in a feed trough
- Scripture doesn't tell us where His clothes came from

Working Clothes

- Shorter, loose-fitting garments
- Wore ordinary clothes to identify with mankind
- Jesus was a carpenter until age 30

His Clothes From The Mockers

- Wore robe stained with purple dye
- Dye was expensive; robe the same as one worn by a king
- Also wore a crown of thorns when crowd mocked Him saying “Hail King of the Jews”

His Clothes The Gamblers Wanted

- Garment was seamless from top to bottom
- Jesus kept His inner garment while the soldiers gambled for His outer garment (tunic)
- Fulfillment of Psalm 22:18

Linen Grave Clothes

- Long linen cloth plus a head napkin
- Head napkins was folded separately from the strips of linen
- Folded head covering was a message taken from Jewish customs at the dining table; it signified that the person who folded the napkin would return
