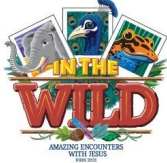

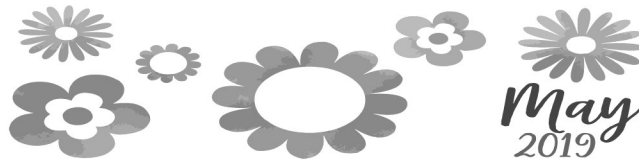

## **“A Hopeful Mother’s Prayer”** **1 Sam. 1:1-2:11**

### **Background**

- Hannah lived in the time of Judges
- She was one of two wives of Elkanah; God permitted polygamy, but it was not His ideal and it caused problems

### **Hannah’s Problem**

- She was childless, which was viewed as a curse from God
- Peninnah, Elkanah’s other wife, had children and ridiculed Hannah for not being able to bear children

### **Hannah’s Prayer**

- Hannah was a godly woman, but the Lord temporarily closed her womb to bring her closer to Him
- She wanted children and prayed for that when their family went to Shiloh

### **Hannah’s Promise**

- In her prayer Hannah made a vow to God that if He gave her a son she would dedicate him to the Lord as a Nazarite
- She kept her vow after Samuel had been weaned; name means “God heard”

### **Hannah’s Prediction**

- Eli the priest saw her in anguish and confused her prayer with drunkenness
- Eli told her that the Lord would grant her prayer; Hannah went home happy and gave birth to Samuel

### **Hannah’s Praise**

- Hannah prayed again, this time a prayer of praise and thanksgiving; God gave her five more children (1 Sam. 2:21)
- Her tribute reminds us of Mary’s song of praise after Jesus’ birth

## Application

- Waiting on God doesn't mean no, but it does mean "not yet"; childlessness does not preclude you from "motherhood"
- Waiting is not passive—use the time to pray and prepare for God's answer
