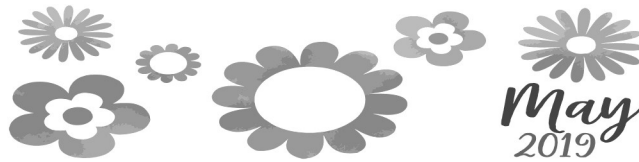

### **Background**

Context of this verse is God speaking to King Solomon after completion of a new Temple for worship  
God laid out a spiritual plan for Israel during hard times when there is trouble in the land

### **The Subjects Of Revival**

Verses apply to believers in God only

Revival is only for Christians—the first question you must ask yourself about your spiritual condition is whether you know God personally at all

### **The Conditions For Revival**

Humility

Prayer

Seeking God’s Face

Turning From Our Wicked Ways

### **The Results Of Revival**

Results are conditional (If...then)

God will hear

God will forgive sin

God will heal our land

### **Application**

Revival is 100% dependent on God, but at the same time we must want spiritual change to happen, and there are things we must do to allow God to work

How badly do you want change?

### **How To Prepare For Revival**

Plan to be here physically & spiritually

Pray for yourself, our church, and others by name who need to be here

Invite someone, offer a ride if needed

### **Prayer For Revival**

Lord we pray that You would revive the hearts of all believers and especially those who have left their first love, become involved in a distorted gospel, fallen into legalism or become lukewarm toward You and draw each one back into a right relationship with You and with each other. Revive Your people we pray and turn the hearts of all Your people back to Yourself, in Jesus name we pray, Amen.
