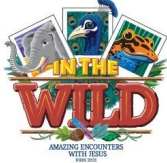

**Rev. Michael Salim Mattar, Sr.**

Rev. Mattar was born in Harper City, Cape Palmas, Maryland County, Republic of Liberia -West Africa. He relocated to the United States in 1980 after the eruption of a civil war in Liberia. He has been married to his lovely wife, Lucretia, for 33 years and has been blessed with 3 wonderful children, Michael Jr. 30 years; Liesl Michelle, 21 years, and Elias Monroe Halim, 17 years. Now, a grandfather to Arie and Maianna. For twelve years, he served as Sr. Pastor for Christian Baptist Church (CBC) while working full time as a Customer Advocacy Manager in the Regulatory Affairs Department at Qwest Communications, eight of those years.

He is very active in the Liberian Community of the Washington Metro Area through proclamation of the Gospel and community outreach which includes; Immigration consultation services, funeral services rendered to members of the community without a home church, offering premarital counseling and performing weddings. Currently, he is a church planter and Sr. Pastor of Hope Fellowship Church, a multi ethnic/multi-cultural church located in Sterling, Virginia. He currently serves as a Board Member for Hindsfeet Ministry, a U.S. based ministry equipping children in Liberia.

Rev. Mattar a founder and Lead Pastor of Hope Fellowship Church in Sterling, Virginia and also he serves with the Montgomery Baptist Association part-time, as the Language Church Missionary, focusing on enhancing and developing MBA's relationship with language mission churches. He serves part-time with the Baptist Convention Maryland/Delaware (BCM/D) on the Church Multiplication Team as an African Church Planting Consultant. Rev. Mattar attended Washington Bible College located in Lanham, MD., where he received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Pastoral Ministries. He also attended Southern Baptist Theological Seminary for the first year of his Master's program, completing his Master's degree in Biblical Counseling at Liberty Baptist Theological Seminary; Lynchburg, Virginia, in May 2010. He is exploring opportunities for Doctorial studies at the moment.
